Driving directions to Royal Victoria hospital in Barrie From IRC

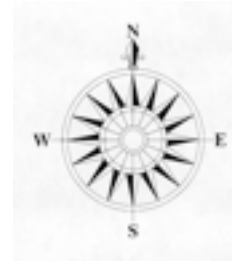
Distance: **22.8 km** Time: **18 mins**

- Start at **7315 YONGE ST, INNISFIL** going toward **8TH LINE** - go **0.4 km**
- Turn Left on **8TH LINE(CR-21)** - go **5.2 km**
- Take ramp onto **HWY-400 N** toward **BARRIE** - go **15.9 km**
- Take exit **#102/DUCKWORTH STREET** - go **0.5 km**
- Continue on **GEORGIAN DR** - go **0.8 km**

Driving directions from Royal Victoria hospital in Barrie to IRC

Arrive at **201 GEORGIAN DR, BARRIE**, on the Right

- Start at **201 GEORGIAN DR, BARRIE** going toward **GOVERNOR'S DR** - go **0.8 km**
- Turn Right on **DUCKWORTH ST** - go **0.3 km**
- Take ramp onto **HWY-400 S** toward **TORONTO** - go **16.4 km**
- Take exit **#85/INNISFIL BEACH ROAD/THORNTON/BARCLAY** - go **0.5 km**
- Turn Left on **8TH LINE(CR-21)**
- Go **5.7 km** Turn Right on **YONGE ST(HWY-11)** - go **0.4 km**,
- Arrive at **7315 YONGE ST, INNISFIL**, on the Left



Roles and Responsibilities

CHARGE PERSON:

- Clear the risk of further harm to the injured person by securing the area and shelter the injured person from the elements
- Designate who is in charge of the other participants
- Protect yourself (wears gloves if she/he is in contact with any body fluids such as blood)
- Assess ABCs (check that airway is clear, breathing and pulse are present, no major bleeding etc.)
- Wait by the injured person till EMS arrives and the injured person is transported
- Fill in Accident Report form

CALL PERSON:

- Call for emergency help
- Provide all necessary information to dispatch (e.g. facility location, nature of injury, what if any, first aid has been done)
- Clear any traffic from the entrance/access road before EMS arrives
- Wait by the entrance to the facility to direct the ambulance when it arrives
- Call the emergency contact person listed on the injured medical profile or contact list
